CAFÉ:

Next term will see the opening of our café, a second servery initially open to sixth form students. In collaboration with abm, our catering providers, a previous second kitchen space has been converted into a lovely café space, reducing seating pressure and queuing times in the main canteen.

ROOF:

Over the Easter holiday and into next term there will be some work done to the EBacc block roof. This should not impact on lessons at all, but we hope will lead to better ventilation and reduced heat gain in this part of the school should we have a heat wave this summer.

DT/ART BLOCK:

In term 6 there will be some major works completed in the Art and Design block, impacting on En7, En8, AD6 and AD4.
